Finally the chassis has arrived home to Austin-Healey Racing Sweden's workshop. The chassis has been painted in silver and assembly has begun.



The team has designed a new type of rocker pedestals. Istvan Popovics has manufactured them in aircraft spec aluminium for the team. They are much stronger than original items and 1/3 of the weight compared to the steel-pedestals offered by other Healey specialists.



Over the last three weeks the car has been assembled bit by bit in the teams workshop.

"It is a true joy to mount all restored and up-dated parts on a brand new chassi" says Anders Schildt, driver and mechanic.



The car is only lacking a few parts, oil and water before the first stat-up and test-run of engine and transmission.




The bodywork is recieving final adjustments and preparations before painting. We hope to have the car fully assembled and ready for track-tests within a month.


